




Creating a patient record in CPMS 2.0

!!!Please note, without consent a patient cannot be discussed in the system!!!

Please note, the following step-by-step guide uses only mock patient data that is not related to any real case to illustrate CPMS 2.0 functionality.

To create a patient record inside CPMS 2.0 follow these steps:

- Go to <u>https://cpms2.ern-net.eu/</u> and log in using your EU login credentials.
- Click on "Add New Patient" in the menu on the left:



 A patient can only be added to the system if they have provided specific consent to discuss their case in the CPMS. To indicate the patient has given their consent, tick yes under "Consent given" (red box in the screenshot below) The optional consents are not applicable for ERN GENTURIS and can be skipped.

Consent for care

Before you can add a patient to the system you must gain their consent. Your hospital has a specific form or procedure to obtain consent from a patient for this system. If you are unaware of this internal procedure, please contact your hospital Data Protection Officer (DPO) and/or ERN specific representative.





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 Once the patient's consent has been confirmed, please provide the patient details. Please note, the data you input here will only be visible to clinicians with an active ERN GENTURIS CPMS account from your hospital.

- Click the "Next" button at the bottom of the page to proceed to the next step.
 - In the next step, set up a nickname and details of the patient, including HCP and thematic area.
 - In the Nickname field, please enter ERN-[Name of your institute]-GENTURIS-[Patient number].

Please note that the system will generate a nickname that looks like a real patient name automatically. Since this could cause confusion regarding patient privacy, we use our own naming convention to nickname ERN GENTURIS patient records. Specifically, [Name of your institute] should be the exact name of your institute that

is indicated in the Healthcare provider field dropdown list (see box 1 in the screenshot below) and [Patient number] should be a consecutive number representing the total number of patients that have been submitted to the CPMS from your institute since 2017.

EXAMPLE: ERN-Radboud University Medical Centre Nijmegen-GENTURIS-0071 (this represents the 71st patient submitted to the CPMS from Radboudumc)

- Please make sure all fields marked with * (mandatory) are filled with the relevant information.
- Please indicate the thematic area (mandatory) and the subthematic area (optional, but highly recommended to fill in if possible) of the patient record as shown in box 2 in the screenshot below.

 A DICOM viewer is included and any DICOM files that are uploaded to the patient record will be recognised as such and can be viewed directly in the system.



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- The "Participants" tab allows you to invite ERN GENTURIS experts based on their self-indicated expertise.
 - Please note that you can only invite a maximum of 10 experts to a patient record, so please make sure you only invite experts with relevant expertise.
 - Click the "Add participant" button to open the participants popup window.
 - Select "GENTURIS" under "ERN" and click the "Search" button to show only ERN GENTURIS experts:
