

How to:

Checklist inviting Panel Members

For step-by-step instructions including screenshots, see *Quick quide 3 – CPMS Dashboard and panel advancement*.

The non-identifiable patient information in your panel can only be accessed by experts that have been invited as "Panel Members".

To invite members to your panel:

- 1. Go to the tab "Panel Members" and select the subtab "Available"
- 2. Select the Thematic Area you want to invite members from (default is the panel's Thematic Area)
- 3. Invite a maximum of 10 members by clicking on "Invite" next to the members you want to invite (Please, do NOT use "Invite all"!)
- 4. Select the subtab "Invited" to view the currently invited members and the status of their invite
- 5. Manually set the "Invited" status to "Accepted" for all your invitees
 - Use the "Accept all" button to do this in one click
