

How to indicate your expertise in the CPMS:

- 1. Go to the CPMS and log in.
- In the menu on the left, click on "GENTURIS" (or ERNs > GENTURIS if you are a member of multiple ERNs)
- 3. In the menu on the left, click on "ERN Preferences"
- Please fill in your professional role at the top (e.g. "clinical geneticist") and tick the boxes for the thematic areas that you have expertise
- 5. Click "Update ERN Preferences" at the bottom of the page (you will get a popup saying "changes saved")
